

National Lottery Awards for All



In 2016/17 we gave out £67.6 million to more than 7,000 projects

- Eligibility smaller grassroots community organisations and larger organisations which are valued by their communities.
- Funding one off activities or testing new ideas.
- Can apply at any time.
- Our most popular programme in England
- Grants of up to £10,000 for one year.

In 2016/17 we gave out £212 million to more than 600 projects

- For ideas costing above £10,000


