

Executive member feedback for Executive meeting August 2018

Empowering People and Communities Project

- The Group met in July to review and input into the delivery of the Health and Well Being Strategy. Meeting on 7th September will pull together findings and look at timelines/funding to deliver this
- Announcements made as to the organisations who were successful in hosting one of the five locality coordinators. The posts have been advertised and the host organisations will have some input into the interviewing of the coordinators. This will take place the beginning of September.

Health and Well-Being

- Systems Transformation Board (STB) membership includes Chief Executive Officers of all systems providers for Northumberland including NTW and NEAS and two federation GP's. Aim to work together to achieve a financial system that has the capacity and capability to drive system change. The STB are focusing on sustainability of the 'system' and changing models of care.
- CCG recognise the pressures of primary care and they are working to identify the most vulnerable practices. In relation to the Northumberland Plan 22,000 homes approved or going through approval and not all in the right place which would require 50 extra GP's
- Northumbria HealthCare NHS Foundation Trust 5 year strategy refresh. Vision to be a leader in providing high quality, safe and caring health and care services. Investing £150 million £92 m in building and estates (incl. Wansbeck and Cramlington), £35m on IT, £23 m on equipment (including CT Scanner and MRI at Hexham)

Emotional Health Support

- Karbon Homes looking at possibility of working with VCS and public sector to develop a programme of interventions to support families in Northumberland experiencing emotional health issues. Need to develop business case for the project. Next meeting 21st August. Public Health, CCG and Leading Link involved in initial meeting.

South East

- Police keen for the voluntary sector's help in getting information out to the community that hate crime will not be tolerated

West

- Report on 'Recharging Rural' which explores issues in rural areas brought to the attention of Executive for future action as has policy and delivery impact on the county and needs to be considered with NCC.
