- Funding and support:
 - Local charities and community groups;
 - Tackling disadvantage, creating stronger communities, making the area a good place to live;
 - £7.78m in 2018-19 (1,515 grants).
- Giving and philanthropy:
 - Generous individuals, families, businesses and charities (250+);
 - Endowment of £82.5m.

- Extremely generous legacy gift.

The FB and PFB Lough Fund

- c£100k per year to support charitable activity in north Northumberland, within a 20-mile radius of Berwick Town Hall (Berwick, Wooler, Bamburgh, Seahouses, Holy Island, Lowick, Ford & Etal...)

Grants that...

- tackle disadvantage;
- strengthen communities;
- make the area a better place to live (culture, environment, sport?)...

... while hitting CF priorities around offering core grants, multi-year grants, and supporting our most-trusted organisations.

The FB and PFB Lough Fund

- £5,000 - £10,000 per year.
- 1, 2, or 3 years' grants.
- Registered charities – core costs, or specific projects.
- Other types of organisation - specific projects only.
- Applications judged on merit, but Community Foundation track record to be taken into account if necessary.

The process

- Open today – www.communityfoundation.org.uk/apply (and follow instructions)
- Deadline – 5th August, 9am
- Decisions – by early October
- Unsuccessful applications – potential to be reallocated to other CF funds.

The process

- Straightforward application form (who you are, what do you want to do, why is it needed, 3x grant objectives).
- Governing document, bank statement, annual accounts, safeguarding policies.

The future

- Additional 2019-20 grant-making TBC.
- 2020-21 and 2021-22 grant-making: amounts TBC based on multi-year commitments made in 2019.
- 2022-23 - Reset!
- 2020s, 2030s, 2040s, 2050s, and beyond - TBC ...

Other Community Foundation opportunities

- General application – apply at any time (up to about £5,000)
- The 1989 Willan Charitable Trust - apply at any time (up to £10,000)
- Community benefit (windfarm) funds for Barmoor and Middlemoor - various deadlines (up to £10,000)
